Preceded by María Isabel de Braganza, gracious founder of the Prado Museum, and followed by the intriguing Neapolitan wife María Cristina, the Saxon queen is well known for the incident that occurred on her wedding night, in which she was disconcerted by the size of her body. virile member of the king, ran out of the bridal chamber after defecating on the sheets in terror. -Dimensions of the image without frame: 54 x 66 cm / 68 x 80 cm with magnificent vintage frame.
