The Battle of Navarino was a naval battle that
took place on October 20, 1827 in the Bay of
Navarino, west of the Peloponnese, between the
Ottoman fleet and a Franco-Russo-British fleet as
part of the intervention of these three powers
during the Greek War of Independence. At the
end of these battles, the Ottoman defeat was total.
