Description

Real table, called cabaret, in solid mahogany, rectangular in shape. The curved top, with rounded corners, it opens to a drawer in the belt and rests on arched legs. Louis XV period. This table is in perfect condition. The cabaret tables, very sought after, designate those having a curved top, in order to hold cups and glasses. These tables appeared from the 17th century, but were very fashionable in the 18th century, with the appearance in particular of chocolate. The greatest cabinetmakers, such as Carlin or RVLC, distinguished themselves with them. We find their small cabaret tables, in particular with orcelaine or lacquer tops, at Camondo.
