This serving table is a fine example of the Art Deco style, which marked the 1920s and 1930s. It is made of walnut and rosewood, two noble and refined species, which form a marquetry with a cube pattern. This geometry creates a dynamic and contrasting visual effect, highlighting the richness and depth of the woods. The table has two levels with raised corners, connected by four fluted, tapered and elegant legs, highlighted by scalloped belts. The main top, larger, has brass handles to facilitate transport and also rests on four tapered and fluted legs.
