Small polychrome Vienna bronze sculpture*, representing a child with his toy, a horse on wheels, from the 19th century. This sculpture is in good general condition. Please note: some tiny chips and losses on the polychromy, scratches and wear of time, see photos. * Vienna bronzes: It is especially in France that the tradition of Vienna bronze figurines is widespread, it will be imported to Vienna by Mathias Bermann, in 1850. The latter specialized in metal ornaments for pipes, it is at this date that he begins to melt and paint figurines. This is the beginning of the Vienna bronzes which were to know a worldwide reputation. Towards the end of the 19th century, golden age of metalworking in Vienna, many workshops were created. During the 19th century, artists created nearly 10,000 models of bronze
