Description

Turned column, executed at the beginning of the 19th century, measuring 51x13.5 cm, of Italian manufacture. An architectural element in the Neoclassical style, an architectural style that echoes the ideals, formal apparatus and rationality in the moulds of classical Greek and Roman architecture. The column in question follows the elegant and precise style typical of this historical period.It is made of Botticino marble, a precious material of Italian origin, quarried in quarries near Brescia. It is characterised by a light, uniform beige shade with subtle ivory white or brown veins. Due to its hardness and strength, this marble is highly valued not only for its aesthetic appearance, but also for its durability. Just above the base, it has a series of decorative motifs with acanthus leaves. The state of
