Magnificent covered cup made by Puiforcat.

The cup rests on a gadrooned pedestal, the body is in plain silver marked with a strong line at mid-height. The rim is chiseled with two double lines.

The cover has the same gadroon frieze as the foot.

The grip is in the shape of a seed emerging from a radiant motif.

The cup is hallmarked:

- . Minerva 1st title before 1973 for 950/00 silver
- . Goldsmith's hallmark: EP with a knife for the house of Puiforcat
- . Boar's head hallmark on the grip
- . In full letters under the cup: Puiforcat // Paris
