Georges Fouillé then turned to maritime painting, appointed permanent painter of the navy, he embarked on the Richelieu, in 1949. Fouillé wanted to combine art with historical research. Georges Fouillé brings to his work a historian's precision. Mr. Fouillé also made figurines of lead
