Very beautiful folio volume in vellum printed in Paris in 1688. "Marca Hispanica sive Limes Hispanicus". Original Edition by Pierre de Marca, Historian of Béarn and Great Jurist of the 17th century (1594-1662). Born in Béarn, he was first President of the Parliament of Navarre and the Council of Pau, then Intendant of Justice in Béarn and Navarre. Widowed in 1642, he entered the Orders and became Bishop of Bouserant (Ariège), then Archbishop of Toulouse (1652), before ending up Archbishop of Paris (1662). His knowledge of the Pyrenees and his legal and historical skills allowed him to be appointed Visitor General of the Principality of Catalonia and the Coasts of Roussillon and Cerdagne (1644). This led to his appointment, in collaboration with the Bishop of Orange, by the
