Description

Auguste Riffatterre (1866-1935), pair of porcelain vases with vegetal and animal decoration in pâte sur pâte, elements and motifs of ivy and gilded insects mounted on black-stained pearwood feet, Limoges, France circa 1900.

Auguste Riffatterre is recorded as a pupil at the municipal school in Limoges in the late 1880s.
