Delicate little teapot in Chinese porcelain, Qing dynasty Yongzheng period (1723 - 1735). Enameled decoration in the palette of the 'famille rose' of birds perched on branches laden with chrysanthemums and lychees... The lid is missing, as is one of the handles. The one that remains is in very finely forged iron. The object itself is in excellent condition, without cracks or chips, and bears on the back an old label written by hand, in ink, in beautiful cursive: "Dynasty of Thzing, 1723 - 1736"...
