Among the most famous figures of Austrian modernism, Carl Aubock (1900 -1957) was the son of an artist, his father of the same name founded the Werkstatte artistic foundry in Vienna in 1900 (still active) where the very young Carl learned the art of forging metals, later studied painting and had the opportunity to attend the Bauhaus.

His wooden objects are rare and extremely sought

The nut or bonbon basket was made of mahogany, entirely hand-worked, with a brass handle in turn finished in woven straw, a distinctive sign of his works. After careful cleaning, it was preferred to leave the brass part in its original patina.
