This sculpture represents Silenus in a dynamic and vigorous pose. In his left hand, he holds a snake that coils around his arm as well as a large circular ring topped with three finely carved acanthus leaves, an architectural element that could suggest a functional use, such as a support for a basin or other decorative objects.Silenus rests on a circular base decorated with stylized plant motifs.Fine carving, particularly of the face, musculature, and
