Gilded and chiseled bronze mount with 4 feet in the shape of acanthus leaves. Upholstered in silk taffeta. Unsigned, typical of the work of Jean-Pierre Tahan (1813-1892), cabinetmaker to Napoleon III.

Missing one pearl in the corner on the back of the box. Slight wear to the gilded bronze mount.
