These two little fans lampshades - they are not exactly a pair, as they in fact have some differences, particularly in the shape - are made of mother-of-pearl obtained from a nautilus shell. The brass tweezers are made of brass in the shape of a lily of Florence, also in this case we point out a difference: one of the tweezers has a side opening - and is slightly looser - the other tweezers have a front opening - and is more rigid
