Color lithograph on brown paper n°130/175 signed at the bottom by the author Félix LABISSE. "Félix Labisse, born March 9, 1905 in Marchiennes and died January 29, 1982 in Neuilly-sur-Seine, was a French surrealist painter that the surrealists, however, refused to recognize as one of their own. On the fringes of André Breton's movement, he was linked in 1947-1948, because of his friendship with Christian Dotremont, to the adventure of revolutionary Surrealism. From the beginning of the 1940s, his work was recognized and supported by Robert Desnos, Paul Éluard, Philippe Soupault, Jacques Prévert. Patrick Waldberg devoted an important monograph to him in 1970. In parallel with his career as a painter, Labisse led a career as a set designer for theater, dance, and opera. » The
