It contains three cylindrical covered containers, in silver-plated metal and surmounted by a Maltese cross. The vessels are marked NH by the goldsmith Nocq Henri, goldsmith who produced liturgical objects in precious or semi-precious metal. The box and containers are in good condition, the caps are easily unscrewed. On one side of the box, stencil and white paint "Stes oils Canton of Trévières" Container diameter 9.5 cm and 18.5 cm high Dimensions of the box 27 x 23 x 13 cm approx. The distribution and use of sacred oils are essential aspects of the sacramental life of parishes, emphasizing the importance of these elements in the Christian liturgy. Each container is called a "chrêmeau" in reference to the "chrism" which is a balsam oil, each container engraved with two letters SC Sanctum Chrisma Holy Chrism Consecration of the Altars, blessing of the bells,.. BONE Oleum Sanctum Oil of the Catechumens, for baptisms OI Oleum Infirmorum Extreme unction For the sick and dying A wooden box marked "SAINTES HUILES CANTON DE TREVIERES" was used by several parishes in the region, Here are some elements concerning its use and the management of sacred liquids:

Service to parishes: In many cases, a box containing the Holy Oils can be used for several parishes. This is especially true in areas where resources can be shared, especially in rural areas or small communities. The sacred oils are blessed during a Chrism Mass, usually celebrated by the bishop and then distributed to the various parishes of his diocese. Transport and storage: The containers inside the box are designed to be transported safely, allowing priests to collect the oils for sacramental celebrations in their respective parishes. The presence of the box also testifies to the desire to keep the oils in a respectful and protected environment. Liquid and Dispensing Management

Responsibility of priests: In each parish, it is usually the priest who is responsible for the management of the Holy Oils. This includes storage, use during the sacraments, and requesting new oils if needed. Priests often go to the Chrism Mass to obtain the oils directly from the bishop or his representative. Role of the bishop: The bishop is responsible for blessing the oils at the Chrism Mass and supervises their distribution to the parishes. The bishop may also establish guidelines for how oils should be used and stored in parishes. Committees or teams: In

some large parishes, there may be teams or committees in charge of the management of the sacraments, including the distribution of oils.

These teams can help ensure that oils are available and used according to Church guidelines. In the 1900s, the canton of Trévières, located in the Calvados department of Normandy, was under the jurisdiction of the Catholic Church. and the canton of Trévières was under the direction of Mgr. Jean-Marie de la Mennais, bishop of Bayeux and several parishes served the local community. 1. Bishop and diocese Bishop:

At the end of the nineteenth century and the beginning of the twentieth century, the bishop of the diocese of Bayeux (which included the canton of Trévières) was Msgr. Jean-Marie de la Mennais. He was appointed Bishop of Bayeux in 1899 and served until his death in 1922. Diocese: The canton of Trévières was part of the diocese of Bayeux and Lisieux, which covers a large part of the Calvados region. The Diocese of Bayeux was established in the sixth century and is one of the oldest dioceses in France. 2.
