Jacques Raymond Brascassat, born Jacques Brascassat on August 30, 1804 in Bordeaux and died in Paris on February 28, 1867, is a French painter and etcher. Note rubbing on the painting as well as cracks, small fungi. The stuccoed gilded frame is damaged in many places. The work is sold uncleaned, unrestored.
