Glassblower's scissors (Glassmaker) 18th century, Louis XV -Louis XVI. Metal instrument with 2 movable and sharp branches on the inside. After having inflated the molten glass leg by blowing into a long hollow metal rod, it is with scissors that the glassblower cuts and evens out the edge of the shape he has just obtained. Raised outer edge allowing the use of gloves. Forged scissors, fixing the branches with a rivet.
