This plate is part of the series of small trades: the grinder. Stamp of the factory under the piece dating between 1875 and 1900 The number 1933 corresponds to the number of the shape of the piece because there is a directory of shaped pieces from Sarreguemines and Digoin The number 225 corresponds to the type of paste used This amusing plate with its text is in perfect condition.
