### Description

Large and beautiful oil on canvas representing the Quais de Trouville, animated by a fish market scene and boats at the quay. Gustave Joseph Florimond Mascart was born in Valenciennes on March 8, 1834 and died in Paris 14th on July 16, 1912. A student of Potter and the naval painter Durand-Brager, he specialized in port or river views, concentrating on landscapes. realistic urban areas. The painting represents the daily life of humble fish sellers in the popular neighborhood of the time. The hall and the buildings at the back, including the old Town Hall, will disappear during the construction of the casino and the expansion of the seaside town. We can note the presence of the steamboat which then made the Caen - Trouville - Honfleur - Le
