Description

Louis XVI period "tric-trac" in mahogany, mahogany veneer, ebony, ivory, It opens with two drawers opposite each other in the belt. The removable double-sided tray is on one side covered in brown leather with a gilded vignette with small iron, which can be used as a desk, and on the back with a checkerboard. equipped with original ivory tokens and two leather goblets and candlesticks. The whole rests on four tapered and deeply fluted legs ending with bronze sabots Louis Aubry (1741 - March 21, 1814) cabinetmaker. Master on August 31, 1774. He lived on rue de Grammont until the Revolution. and then took over his father-in-law's former workshop, rue Saint-Nicolas. He produced Transition furniture, in particular chests of drawers with projections and Louis XVI
