This painting by Georges Pacouil depicts a summer scene on the Pont au Double in the 5th arrondissement of Paris. Soft light bathes the iconic bridges and buildings, including the Petit Pont Cardinal Lustiger in the background, linking the banks of the Seine. To the left is the Square René Viviani, while to the right, the imposing former Prefecture of Police adds a touch of history.

Montclard Anglards-de-Salers 15380 simple dress, typical of the 1950s, and the soft colors create an atmosphere of innocent happiness. Pacouil uses light, impressionistic brushstrokes, evoking calm and fluidity, particularly in the reflections of the water and the foliage of the trees.
