A section of a base worked in interlacing, square, two vases with handles called urns, with lions' heads carrying the rings in their mouths, garlands of laurels on the belly of the body and candlesticks which closed end in a pinnacle which returned constitute a judicious candlestick of very beautiful appearance, classic, in the taste of the garden ornaments of the century of enlightenment These two beautiful pieces of remarkable density (lost wax) in quality bronze giving these two pieces a wonderful polish and patina.
