Its elegance is accentuated by the pure gold gilded finish, which gives it a bright and luxurious appearance. It is a wall cabinet, designed to be fixed to the wall. It is supported by two legs that fold elegantly towards the wall, creating an effect of lightness and movement. This feature makes it ideal for smaller environments, where limited floor space can be optimised. The consolle top is of excellent quality and has a wooden recess painted in imitation yellow Siena marble. This finish adds a touch of elegance and refinement to the furniture, the top is also spacious and functional, perfect for displaying decorative objects or using it as a support for small objects.
