He also presented a Roger de la Fresnaye exhibition in Charlieu in 1975... ...Watercolour was his favourite technique, which was all the more easily practised during his many trips in search of motifs. Although he gradually explored landscape themes, it was seascapes, water and boats that particularly required his greatest attention.
