Via Maggio 63 / rosso Firenze 50100 along with the natural dynamics of the scene, highlights affinities with the Barbizon school, known for its portrayal of rural life and atmospheric landscapes. Frame: The frame, in gilded wood and pastiglia, shows signs of wear and is contemporary to the painting but requires restoration. Condition: The painting is in simply good original condition. Additional notes: On the back of the panel, inscriptions suggest an old attribution to Jules Jacques Veyrassat. There is also a 19th-century label with the number '62' and a partially legible word, possibly referring to an exhibition or a

collection.
