Jacques Duthoo has his own identity, his own style that he has been developing since childhood and which makes his works unique and recognizable even without a signature, the best proof of his artistic presence... Whether he uses watercolor or pastel, his characters on the border between abstract and real, often seem mysterious and attract the eye,

It was in 1992 that he had the opportunity to exhibit for the first time at the Fête des peintres in Chanceaux-près-Loches, (He would repeat the experience every year until 1997). At the same time, Christian Dupont would regularly offer, at the Atelier (Loches), the works of Jacques

Duthoo, notably in 1995 for an exhibition that
