GUARD RING called FUSHI Japan Edo period (1603-1868) Signed Iron, copper and gold H. 3.6; L. 2.1; Thickness 1.3 cm

Iron fushi decorated with three three-lobed leaves - one of which is copper - branches enhanced with gold, a silver flower bud and five motifs, probably heraldic.

Located between the handle (the tsuka) and the guard (the tsuba), the fushi serves to reinforce the tsuka.
