Eugène Henri Cauchois, 1850-1911, French painter of flowers, fruits, genre scenes, landscapes, seascapes and still lifes. He was a student of Cabanel and Duboc at the Académie de Paris at the Ecole Nationale des Beaux-Arts. He participated in the Paris Salon from 1874 where he won numerous awards. At the end of his life, he devoted himself to decorative painting, painting, among other things, flower panels for a school in the 7th arrondissement of Paris. He
