



Louis XIII Style Bonnetière In Fruit Wood And Miscellaneous, 1 Door Wardrobe, Diamond Points



Description

Beautiful Louis XIII style bonnet or single-door wardrobe from the 18th century and opening with a door on the front. It rests on two ball feet at the front and two straight feet at the back. The door is nicely worked and made up of three panels carved with diamond point patterns. The sides are in strips. Our piece of furniture has several types of wood, fruit for the front, oak and various for the rest of the piece of furniture. The back bottoms are very thick. The two back feet have been anted on about five cents. The two ball feet, as well as the base molding above them, have been redone. The interior of this single-door wardrobe is covered with a patterned fabric on a red background. The lock is original and works perfectly.
