## Description

Magnificent velvet dance card decorated with a fine sheet of finely engraved solid silver. This superb notebook presents a goldsmith's work with a meticulous cutting of the silver, engraved with a burin with great precision. In the center, in a delicate silver cartouche, is a splendid miniature in warm and vibrant colors, probably done in gouache. The landscape represents a lively waterfall in the foreground, observed by two characters on the left. In the background, the tumultuous water pours into a large expanse lined with trees, offering a poetic scene worthy of a great painter. The interior of the notebook is lined with turquoise blue fabric. A handwritten page is present, bearing a name and a date: June 22, 1897, probably an invitation for a future dance. Small detail to note: the original pencil, which
