Christofle Alfenide cutlery set Ruban model in its box with 3 storage drawers with their punches of 73 pieces including: -12 forks -12 knives -12 spoons -12 teaspoons -12 dessert knives -12 dessert forks -1 ladle This box also includes 1 Durousseau Raynaud fish service of 33 pieces in hallmarked silver metal including: -12 fish forks -12 fish knives -9 oyster forks Alfenide concerns the Christofle Goldsmith brand which used this alloy as a base for the manufacture of tableware by electroplating such as silver-plated cutlery. Alfenide is also called white metal, it is an alloy composed of 59% copper, 30% zinc, 10% nickel and 1% iron. It is then covered with silver by electroplating. The Alfenide brand was used by Christofle until the last filing on October 24, 1978. Not having been renewed, this brand
