Self-taught, he took up his brushes in 1943, initially working on portraits and caricatures. After the war, he began his long journey towards non-figuration, which led him to flamboyant pieces, with thick materials and deconstructed geometric figures. During his life, Loth was a friend of the discreet painter Jean Boyé from Périgord, and of the great Roger Bissière, who was a great inspiration. The painter's subjects are varied: modeled landscapes whether they are from Périgord or the Arcachon Basin, cubic urban landscapes, portraits and
