Description

Pair Of Gilded Carved Frames made of stone pine wood with a triumph of crumpled leaves around the main rectangular frame with the edges decorated with carved and gilded beading. In a good state of preservation apart from old restorations due to the fragility of the frame. Two mercury mirrors from the 18th century have been inserted into the frames. Northern Italy 1800.

These period frames are hand-carved with a carving of acanthus leaves and volutes, a cartouche decoration, deep in the upper part and more airy, openwork in the lower decoration. The central reservoir is rectangular in shape with a carved beading profiling the edge. The delicate frames are gilded and are in a good state of

preservation, old restorations evident from the photographic details, a gluing on a curl and minimal gilding, as highlighted in the photo gallery. Due to their small size, these small antique Italian mirrors can be hung on the wall or decorate a piece of furniture. They come from a private collection, Northern Italy, early 1800s.
