Superb solid silver Art Deco tumbler by the famous goldsmith Ravinet d'Enfert.

The tumbler rests on a plain silver pedestal.

The body of the tumbler is also in plain silver, marked halfway up with a large hollow line.

The tumbler is hallmarked:

. Minerva 1st title before 1973 for 950/00 silver

. RD goldsmith's hallmark with a clover for Ravinet d'Enfert.

In 1891, Charles d'Enfert and Louis Ravinet joined forces to form the Ravinet d'Enfert company. In 1923 the company was taken over by the children of the two partners. Gold medals
