Second half of the 20th century France -Auvergne - Haute-Loire This beautifully decorated lace folder reveals much more than a simple utilitarian object. Although it is a late production, it is faithfully inspired by the ancient codes of folk art, with a precision and authenticity that recall the artisanal practices of the past. This type of folder, sometimes called a "good fake", wonderfully embodies traditional folk aesthetics by respecting the symbols and the style of knife carving. What is a "good fake"? In art history, the term "good fake" refers to pieces made well after the original period, but with rigorous respect for ancient styles and techniques. This folder, although recent, faithfully reflects the Auvergne folk art of the 19th century. Unlike an object that seeks to deceive, this is a sincere homage, where

the craftsman has recreated the traditional motifs and symbols - wheels, rosettes, hearts and wolf teeth - while preserving the spirit of this era. In each line, each curve, we perceive the dexterity of the craftsman, transforming this modest object into a living evocation of local culture and its timeless imagery.
