The top is decorated with a nipple-shaped grip. The upper part unscrews to open onto the original wooden spool around which the thread is wound, and which supports a thimble.

This beautiful barrel rests on a base that is also decorated.

The whole is in perfect condition and working order.

A beautiful work of a turner or sailor from the Napoleon III period.

A luxurious solid ebony reel, a beautiful collector's item.
