The stylish frame is adorned with two elegant finials and reinforced with turned braces at both the top and bottom of the uprights. The mirror is held in place by pins with decorative brass knobs. The piece stands on splayed reeded feet with the original capped brass castors. The back is paneled in mahogany, showcasing a wonderful original finish and color throughout. Made in England, circa 1810.
