The mirrors, in good condition, are adorned in the center by two engraved figures - a man and a woman - representative of classical themes, complete with garments, ornaments, and symbols representing the allegory of the seasons. These mirrors, of undeniable taste and refinement, can bring class and elegance to any environment. Made by a Neapolitan workshop during the neoclassical period, between the late 18th and early 19th century.
