



Chasuble With 7 Medallions Painted With Gold Threads, With Its Stole And Manipule, Liturgical Vest



Description

Chasuble from the end of the 19th century, probably in gilded lamé and decorated with 7 hand-painted medallions with floral decoration, a heart surrounded by a crown of thorns and a central medallion painted with a child born from a rose with the phrase: in this rose our life is enclosed.

This chasuble is sold with its étole and a manipule with the same decoration. The chasuble is worn on the back and the ohotos speak for themselves. comes from a regional inheritance but in the past the set that we are selling was used for worship at the Gard Abbey in Amiens in the Somme Valley.
