Eugène-Antoine AIZELIN (1821-1902). Ferdinand Barbedienne (1810-1892). Paris. 19th century, circa 1880. Bust of a young woman entitled "Mignon". Bronze sculpture with brown patina. Signed Eugène Aizelin, F. Barbedienne Fondateur. Numbered in hollow 38 below. References noted in ink. Bears the stamp Mechanical reduction A. Collas. Molded base in red griotte marble. Total height 43cm. (Bronze alone 32cm).

at the Opéra-Comique in Paris on November 17,
1866 under the direction of Théophile Tilmant.
