Constructed from solid mahogany, it features a molded edge with ebony stringing throughout.

The rectangular top, with rounded molded corners, showcases a beautifully patinated green tooled leather inset. Beneath are six mahogany-lined drawers, three on each side, all retaining their original brass turned knob handles, working locks, and a functioning key. The elegant table is raised on end supports, with reeded splayed saber legs that terminate in brass caps and original brass castors. Made in England, circa 1800, this writing table boasts a rich mahogany brown color and is in superb original condition.
