Description

Beautiful mahogany chest of drawers with 2 drawers, with rich gilded bronze ornamentation: pearl threads, flower sprays highlight the play of the work of speckled or veneered mahogany

Beautiful chest of drawers topped with an African onyx top

This chest of drawers bears the stamp of "Mon Krieger Ameublement Paris" on the uprights and on the lock

Traces of break-in at the drawers (the wood is crushed), missing on one side, traces of use and old restorations to the marble

Krieger and his brother Nicolas in premises at 17, rue Saint-Nicolas in Paris.

She initially distinguished herself in the cabinetmaking business, with a production of luxury furniture, inspired by the creations of masters of previous centuries and of an unprecedented quality of manufacture, before developing a department dedicated to decoration. Her original creations, notably for the Universal Exhibitions, allowed her to win awards, notably a 2nd class Medal in London in 1852. Her successors continued to use her brand after her death, her workshop becoming the company "Antoine Krieger et Companie".
