Description

Fireplace in Burgundy stone, Farges stone in Saône et Loire, from the Louis XVI period in perfect condition. Its lintel, called "three sculpted rosettes", rests on jambs, in a light console, cut in sheath and adorned with rudenté channels. On request, its returns reported in the 20th century can be manually recut and patinated, its significant depth can be cut to the desired size. Its length at the body is 155 cm.
