He was sentenced to death as a traitor to the fatherland for "having publicly slandered a battalion of brave national guards ... having served the atrocious projects of the conspiratorial deputies, having spoken with great warmth in a reading room ... having vomited the blackest and most base slanders against the Parisian generals ..."
