Almost no restoration, almost intact, missing a finger on the right hand.

This Saint Sebastian here represented as a martyr is presented standing in contrapposto, naked and leaning against a tree trunk to which he is tied by the wrists, his right arm raised in an elegant movement above his head and in an attitude
