




Raoul Dufy Print "the Rudder" Queen Mary Signed

Presented as the rudder of the Queen Mary in 1937, this engraving on paper with the filagras "pur fil Marais" is marked and signed at the bottom right "gouvernail Dufy" Raoul Dufy must have made the crossing to New York in 1937 1937 or 1949
