Biography: Italian designer born in 1942, Franco Mirenzi began his professional career in 1964 in Milan, where he worked at the headquarters of Unimark International. In Italy, his clients include Agip, Boston, Brionvega, Cedit, Citterio, Dreher, Fabbri, General Electric, Honeywell, Molteni, Norex, Sirrah and Unifor.
