Pierre Dufourcq Bidau, originally from Béarn, a banker by profession, gathered his collection with the help of his friend Giovanni Franco Scanzi, author of the reference work, dedicated to the slingshot "Potomo Waka," An article in the newspaper, Sud Ouest, of November 8, 1988, speaks of the collection of Mr. Dufourcq Bidau, as the second largest collection of slingshots in the world after that of Scanzi.
